IF YOU PLAN TO APPLY FOR THE PTCO ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP WHEN YOU ARE A SENIOR, YOU NEED TO DO AN ADDITIONAL 5 HOURS OF SERVICE HELPING THE PTCO OR SELL \$50 WORTH OF PTCO FUNDRAISER PRODUCTS. THESE HOURS MAY BE COMPLETED ANYTIME DURING YOUR FOUR YEARS IN HIGH SCHOOL. THESE HOURS CANNOT BE USED TOWARD YOUR GRADUATION COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS.

THESE ARE JUST SOME SUGGESTED COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

- Benefit dinners (act as server or cleanup) – Lions’ Club pancake breakfast or Top Ten Banquet (server or cleanup)
- Light House cleanup (pick up trash, clear leaves, etc.)
- Volunteer at Humane Society
- Clean up cemeteries or church grounds
- Volunteer at Northshore Retirement Center (read to residents, play games with residents)
- Volunteer at Danbury Senior Center (clean up the facility, yard work)
- Plant flowers and clean landscaped areas for Village of Marblehead and/or Danbury Township
- Clean or work at the Danbury Lending Library – Ex Libris
- Trash pick-up at East Harbor State Park
- Work at a food pantry (St. Paul Lutheran Church)
- Donate Blood (counts as 1 hour)
- Help with Daisy Days 5K Run in May
- James Park Clean up
- Help coach a youth athletic group (baseball, softball, soccer, basketball, volleyball, etc.)
- Participate in the “Staff vs Student” basketball PTCO Fundraiser
- Help distribute PTCO Fundraiser items
- A MAXIMUM of 5 hours per year may be earned for helping with sports camps.

These are some suggestions. You may clear other projects with the HS Principal.

Volunteer work done for a relative or school club (NHS, Key Club, etc.) will not count. The community service must be beyond your other commitments and must be for a non-profit organization. (You may not work without pay for any retail store/company.)
